





2024-2025 Program Service Impact

Kinder Kamp

- 187 students enrolled in 17 classrooms in all 6 Huntington County Community Schools
- 2-week, half-day school preview to enhance Kindergarten Readiness
- 75% attendance rate

Ride United Last Mile Delivery

- 3,648 teen packs delivered to Huntington County middle and high school students
- Delivered food items to sustain students through weekends

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library

- 14,845 free, age-appropriate, high-quality books delivered to children aged birth to 5
- Available to all children aged birth to 5, at no cost to the family, regardless of income
- 1,146 (55%) of Huntington County children from birth to 5-year-olds are enrolled

Food Drive

- Partnered with Ecolake Foods
- Over 130 pounds of rice and beans collected
- Distributed to the food pantry at United With Love

Boxed Fan Distribution

- Partnered with Huntington County Emergency Management and Indiana Family Care Center
- 100 boxed fans distributed to Huntington County residents in August 2024 during heat wave

Point in Time item collection

- Partnered 3 local credit unions
- Collected hats, gloves, hand warmers
- Distributed to those in need during January 2025






